

**6. RICCARTON/WIGRAM ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE
REPORT OF 16 MARCH 2004 MEETING**

The Board considered the report of the Environment Committee meeting of Tuesday 16 March 2004.

Following a presentation on the Ocean Outfall Wastewater Proposal, the Committee sought to submit a submission that the quality of the outfall be to the same standard as would be provided in the estuary, and that the addition of an ultra violet plant need not be part of the Ocean Outfall proposal.

The Committee visited the Carmen/Peebles/Showgate Corridor Pathway Linkage enhancement work, as a new capital works project. Subject to an estimate being provided, the Committee was supportive of funding this work.

The Committee also gave consideration to its participation in the October 2004 Heritage Week celebrations. It was noted that the Board was currently assisting the Riccarton Racecourse Trustees in the restoration of the 1903 Tea House. The Committee is also supporting the restoration of the Hornby School War Memorial/Water Tower project.

The Board **agreed** to prepare a submission on the Ocean Outfall Waste Water proposal and to participate in Heritage Week.
