10. OXFORD TERRACE/MADRAS STREET: CHANGES TO PARKING MANAGEMENT

The Committee considered a report seeking approval for changes to parking restrictions in the area of the Firefighters Reserve in Madras Street.

The report noted that construction of the second stage of the Firefighters Reserve was about to commence and as a consequence new parking restrictions would need to be implemented as the layout of car parking in the area would change.

It is proposed to provide for two-hour time restrictions in the remaining parking spaces in Oxford Terrace adjacent to the reserve and as there is a net loss in parking spaces with the Reserve area to convert the 'all-day' parks (5 spaces) on the east side of Madras Street between Chester Street East and Oxford Terrace to a two-hour time limit. The report noted that the change in parking management was supported by the adjacent Baptist Church.

On the west side of Madras Street, there is an existing no stopping restriction in the block between Chester Street East and Kilmore Street, however, with the proposed kerb extension south of the Avon River, parking could be reinstated between the proposed kerb extension and Chester Street East (six spaces). It is restricted to a two-hour time limit to match the parking limit on the other side of Madras Street.

The parking restrictions for the east side of Madras Street and for Oxford Terrace have been considered and approved by the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board.

The Committee resolved:

- 1. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum time limit of 120 minutes on the west side of Madras Street commencing at a point 7m north of its intersection with Chester Street East and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 34m.
- 2. That the existing parking restrictions in the abovementioned area be revoked.
