

2. CITYWIDE PUBLIC TRANSPORT PRIORITY PLAN



This report was first received by the Board's Transport and Roading Committee, but was held over to the Board meeting for full discussion.

Rob Woods, Transport Planner, was in attendance to present this comprehensive plan. It has been prepared as a first step towards the development of public transport priority measures across the city. The aim of the plan is to provide a more convenient metro public transport system with the efficiency and reliability necessary to encourage more people to make more bus trips in deference to car trips.

A variety of views was expressed by members on the "aims" of the Plan.

It was moved:

"That this Board does not support the current thrust on bus prioritisation and would like to see a detailed report covering the integration of all modes of transport."
