RELEVANT CURRENT POLICY

This project forms part of the Transport and City Streets and Greenspace Unit's Capital Expenditure Programme for the 2004/05 year and is shown on page 125 and 139 of the Financial Plan and Programme.

DESCRIPTION

The contract is for the construction of kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, landscape planting, grassed berms, drainage works, new culverts/bridges, waterway shaping, retaining walls and carriageway construction.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

Calcon Limited \$1,304,884.55

City Care Limited \$1,579,984.40

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$135,000 and the work is for a 37 week period.

The estimate for the work was \$1,554,000.

RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved. Minor changes have had to be made to the design shown on the publicity leaflet.

Stewart Callaway of Calcon Limited has given an assurance that the work can be completed within the specified time.
