11. REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE: 18 MAY 2004 (Cont'd)

Further to clause 4 (Part B) of this report the Board **resolved** to accept an apology for absence from Rod Cameron. The Board also **resolved**:

11.1 Salisbury Street Construction Zone

To approve the temporary construction zone as set out in clauses 1 and 2 of the Traffic Engineer's report.

11.2 Salisbury Street Residents Only Parking

That the parking of vehicles be restricted to "vehicles displaying residents' permits only at any time" on the northern side of Salisbury Street commencing at a point 11.5 metres from its intersection with Colombo Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 6.5 metres.

11.3 London Street: Tree Removal

- 1. That subject to consultation with the local residents' group and immediate neighbours, to approve the removal of the box elder and its replacement with a large nursery stock tree of the same variety not less than 3.5 metres in height.
- 2. That the applicant pay the full cost of removing the existing tree and the cost of providing and planting the replacement tree.
- 3. That staff investigate and take action to replace other trees that have been removed from Council land in London Street.

11.4 Ihutai Management Plan 2004: Submissions

To support the Ihutai Management Plan 2004 and, if possible, to make a supplementary submission to the Council's Long Term Council Community Plan 2004/2014 to that effect.
