

## 8. QEII PARK ICE STADIUM TRUST

The Assets and Business Adviser provided the Board with details of the consultation process in respect to the QEII Ice Stadium Trust proposal and sought Council support for the leasing of an area of land for this purpose to the QEII Ice Stadium Trust. Revised staff recommendations were tabled.

Andy Lea moved by way of an amendment:

- "1. That, before the Council endorse the findings of the consultative process for the provision of publicly available ice skating facilities at QEII, there be a further request for submissions made to the Ascot/Freeville Residents' Group, Parklands Residents' Association, North New Brighton Residents' Association, Northshore Residents' Association and Queenspark Residents' Association."*

The amendment was seconded by Carmen Hammond and when put to the meeting was declared **carried** on division no 1 by 6 votes to 4, the voting being as follows:

**For (6):** Andrews, Burt, Hammond, Kellaway, Lea, and Rowlands.

**Against (4):** Evans, James, Sheriff and Williams.

The Board **decided** to recommend to the Community and Leisure Committee:

1. That, before the Council endorses the findings of the consultative process for the provision of publicly available ice skating facilities at QEII, there be a further request for submissions made to the Ascot/Freeville Residents' Group, Parklands Residents' Association, North New Brighton Residents' Association, Northshore Residents' Association and Queenspark Residents' Association.
2. That the Council seek Requests for Proposals for an organisation to lease land at QEII for the purpose of building and operating an ice skating facility, including a requirement for interested organisations to submit a feasibility study.
