

3. WORKS, TRAFFIC AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 16 APRIL 2004

The Board considered the report and recommendations of the Committee's meeting held on 16 April 2004 and **decided**:

3.1 HARAKEKE STREET – TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

3.1.1 Harakeke Street – Pedestrian Safety

That the proposed project to improve pedestrian safety and convenience at the Harakeke Street Avon River bridge be endorsed for consultation with the local community.

3.1.2 Harakeke Street/Rochdale Street – Traffic Concerns

1. That the report be received.
2. That the residents' various concerns be further addressed at the time of the reconstruction of Rochdale Street (2006/07) and Harakeke Street (2008/09).
3. That the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board explore the option of Harakeke Street (Rochdale to Kilmarnock) being advanced in the programme from the 2008/09 year.

3.2 CYCLE STRATEGY – DRAFT UPDATED 2004 VERSION

That the submission prepared on the Council's revised Cycle Strategy, as amended, be adopted.

3.3 AVICE HILL RESERVE – FRONTAGE ENHANCEMENT

That the proposal for the enhancement of the frontage of the Avice Hill Reserve be approved for consultation with the local residents and users of the Avice Hill Art and Craft facility.

3.4 RIVERSIDE PLANTING

That the Wairarapa Stream site and the Avon River site be submitted for assessment.
