15. COMMUNITY COMPOSTING UNITS



The Committee considered a report from the Chairman on a meeting he had recently attended with the Hagley Ward Resident's Associations and the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board at which it was suggested that community composting units be provided by the Council for community use, located on appropriate sites owned by the Council.

It had been suggested that Moa Reserve could be utilised as a trial site and the local community had agreed to participate in operating a community composting unit.

That Committee **decided** that staff investigate and if appropriate proceed with a trial community composting unit at the Moa Reserve and in due course report on its success and the possibility of extending this scheme to other areas of the city.
