12. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT



12.1 Deputation: Noel Alexander, Proposed Sculpture

Noel Alexander (Sculptor) addressed the Board regarding a proposed sculpture to be sited at the reserve at the corner of Waltham Road and Moorhouse Avenue. Mr Alexander presented a design incorporating four wands intended to honour achievement in literature, sport, visual arts and education/science/technology at an estimated cost of \$5,000-\$6,000.

The Board decided:

- 1. To request that firm costings be obtained for the sculpture.
- 2. To recommend investigation of a shared payment for the sculpture from the Board's funds and the Art in Public Places integrated budget.

12.2 Deputation: Colin Campbell, Proposed Road Stopping on Moncks Spur

Colin Campbell addressed the Board regarding the proposed road stopping on Moncks Spur. (Refer also to clause 2.) Mr Campbell expressed some concern at:

- 1. the proposed covenant protecting existing planting; and
- 2. the proposed boundaries of the parcels of land to be stopped.

The Board received the information.

12.3 Deputations By Appointment: Charleston Residents' Association

John Hoskin and David Riley from the Charleston Residents' Association addressed the Board regarding funding for challenging Leopard Coachlines' resource consent application for activities associated with its bus depot on Ensors Road. It was **moved** that the Board seek an urgent report on the ability of residents' groups to access technical information, expert evidence and legal advice from the Council for resource consent applications and hearings.

The motion was declared **carried** on division no 1 by six votes to one, the voting being as follows:
