



1. COMMUNITY BOARD CODE OF CONDUCT

The General Manager Regulation and Democracy Services, Peter Mitchell, reported on the deliberations of a Joint Community Board Working Party regarding a Community Board Code of Conduct.

The draft is similar to that adopted by the Council. The Working Party's view was that all Community Boards should each have the same Code of Conduct for ease of administration and consistency across the city. The Code has been adapted to apply specifically to Community Board members.

Whilst the Board was supportive of the draft, it was **decided** that the proposed Code be deferred and that it be considered by the incoming Board.
