9. KIPLING STREET KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL: PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Board's approval was sought to implement parking restrictions in Kipling Street.

It was resolved:

- 1. That all existing no stopping restrictions relating to the area covered by the Kipling Street kerb and channel reconstruction be revoked.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time in the following areas:
 - (i) On the north side of Brougham Street, commencing at its intersection with Kipling Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
 - (ii) On the north side of Brougham Street, commencing at its intersection with Kipling Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 33 metres.
 - (iii) On the west side of the formed carriageway of Kipling Street, commencing at its intersection with Brougham Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 65 metres.
 - (iv) On the east side of Kipling Street, commencing at its intersection with Brougham Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 66 metres.
