



19. TENNYSON STREET AND LYTTTELTON STREET OFF-ROAD AND ON-ROAD CYCLING FACILITIES - EVALUATION

The Committee received a report from Michael Ferigo, Transport Planner - Cycling and Pedestrians, Transport and City Streets Unit informing it of the results of the evaluations in respect to cycling projects on Tennyson Street and Lyttelton Street. The report provided background to the Council's cycle strategy and the issue of on-road or off-road facilities together with an evaluation of the two streets, details of the methodology used, and the results and feedback from residents, cyclists and motorists. The report noted that positive levels of satisfaction existed in the community for these two major capital redevelopment projects

The Committee **decided**:

1. That the report be received.
2. That the crash rates for Tennyson Street be continued to be monitored for a further three year period.
3. That any significant variations to the results of the Lyttelton Street evaluation after the additional surveying of cyclists is completed in 2004 be reported.
