NEW BRIGHTON ROAD LANDSCAPING



A letter was received from G Craig, New Brighton Horticultural Society, regarding concerns about the planting of cabbage trees along the berm of the recent reconstruction of New Brighton Road (Bower Avenue to Hawke Street).

The Board noted the concerns expressed in a resident's letter to Carole Evans and asked that officers take into consideration the identified safety issues at 504 New Brighton Road.

The Board **decided** to write to the Horticultural Society to thank them for their letter, to explain the situation more clearly and to circulate a copy of the letter from the Council officer that details widespread support for the cabbage trees along New Brighton Road.

The meeting adjourned at 5.40 pm for the presentation of Certificates of Appreciation and an informal update on the New Brighton Revitalisation Project. The meeting reconvened at 7.25 pm.
