9. COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE DECISIONS

In accordance with the recommendations made by the Community Services Committee, the Board resolved:

- 1. To approve a grant of \$2,765 to the Salvation Army Hornby for a six-month budget advisory service, to be funded from the Community Initiatives Project Fund 2004/05.
- 2. To endorse the draft submission to Parliament's Justice and Electoral Select Committee on the 2004 local authority elections, subject to the deletion of the clause on "Requirement for Community Board Candidates to be resident in the Community".
