


#### 4. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

##### 4.1 COMMUNITY SWIMMING POOLS



Lynda Goodrick, Belfast Co-ordinator and a teacher from the Papanui Primary school spoke to the Board regarding the operation of the community swimming pools.

The submitters expressed dissatisfaction on behalf of their relevant committees on the operating costs and the opening hours of the pools and the proposed date of closure for the season.

They also stated that there had been a lack of communication by Council staff following the meeting held at the Papanui Service Centre on 10 March 2004.

The Board **resolved** that a Board Subcommittee meet with the relevant staff and members of the Edgware, Papanui and Belfast swimming pools to address the concerns raised and decide on a way forward.

##### 4.2 ST ALBANS APARTMENT DEVELOPMENTS

Mr John Knox and Ms Patricia Allard of 70d Champion Street, presented a submission to the Board in opposition to the AEL (Advancing Enterprise Limited) investor developments of high density rental units under construction throughout the St Albans residential area.

The Chairperson informed the submitters that she was meeting with the General Manager City Environment and undertook to forward this submission for the General Manager's attention.

##### 4.3 BELFAST/NORTHWOOD RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION

Mr Don Pope of the Belfast/Northwood Residents' Association spoke to the Board about the Belfast/Northwood Residents' Association. Mr Pope informed the Board that the Residents' Association had drawn up its constitution.

The Board **decided** that the Residents' Association be allocated a grant of \$200 to set up its constitution and that this be met from the Board's 2004/05 discretionary budget.
