

10. CIVIL DEFENCE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Board considered the draft Civil Defence Emergency Management Plan and **resolved**:

1. To provide a submission on the draft Plan suggesting that, as part of the Plan, community boards could sponsor local seminars in order to increase awareness and participation.
2. To invite Civil Defence representatives to discuss the Plan with the Board and determine how best to involve the community.
