

2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

2.1 PATTEN STREET SAFETY ISSUES

Nicky Appleby, a resident of Patten street addressed the board regarding safety issues and street design.

Mrs Appleby presented a petition to the Board signed by 24 people supporting her deputation.

Mrs Appleby submitted that the following issues were of concern:

1. The speed of traffic.
2. The street is used as a through route and has heavy traffic volumes. The street is used by cyclists, buses and is on a school route.
3. The deep gutters mean drivers park further out onto the road.
4. There is no centre white line on the road.

The Board thanked Mrs Appleby for her presentation and **decided** to seek a report from the Transport and City Streets Unit outlining:

1. Current traffic volume statistics.
2. Current accident statistics.
3. Measures that can be undertaken on the kerb and channel in the interim.
4. When reconstruction on the street is due to be completed.
