## 2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

## 2.1 PATTEN STREET SAFETY ISSUES

Nicky Appleby, a resident of Patten street addressed the board regarding safety issues and street design.

Mrs Appleby presented a petition to the Board signed by 24 people supporting her deputation.

Mrs Appleby submitted that the following issues were of concern:

- 1. The speed of traffic.
- 2. The street is used as a through route and has heavy traffic volumes. The street is used by cyclists, buses and is on a school route.
- 3. The deep gutters mean drivers park further out onto the road.
- 4. There is no centre white line on the road.

The Board thanked Mrs Appleby for her presentation and **decided** to seek a report from the Transport and City Streets Unit outlining:

- Current traffic volume statistics.
- 2. Current accident statistics.
- 3. Measures that can be undertaken on the kerb and channel in the interim.
- 4. When reconstruction on the street is due to be completed.
