

## 4. RICCARTON/WIGRAM TRANSPORT AND ROADING COMMITTEE REPORT OF 25 FEBRUARY 2005 MEETING

The Board considered the report of the Transport and Roading Committee meeting of Friday 25 February 2005.

## 1. O'Halloran Drive/Muir Avenue Traffic Safety Works

The Committee received a deputation from local residents concerning a City Streets proposal for O'Halloran Drive/Muir Avenue Traffic Safety Works, which would see the installation of a roundabout. Whilst the City Streets Unit provided technical justification for this work, members were of the view that the proposal did not have sufficient community support at this time; there were concerns also about some of the technical aspects of the project.

Accordingly the Board **decided** to accept the Committee recommendation that a public meeting be held to discuss this proposal, and that it be reported back to Transport and Roading Committee for further consideration.

## 2. Transit New Zealand Issues

Tony Spowart was in attendance to discuss various projects that Transit New Zealand had on their Capital Works Programme. A copy of the Draft Ten Year State Highway Plan was also tabled for members' consideration.

At the Board meeting, members expressed concerns about the lack of consultation and consideration that was now available for the Community Board to consider this important document. (Submissions closed with Transit New Zealand on 17 March 2005).

Accordingly, the Board **decided** that in view of the significant traffic issues within the Riccarton/Wigram community, the Board write to the Chief Executive Officer expressing its concerns that the document from Transit New Zealand was not circulated to all Boards to allow them to give full consideration to this important issue.

## 3. Installation of "Give Way" Controls

The Committee was supportive of two reports requesting the installation of "Give Way" controls at three intersections in Riccarton.

The Board's decisions are recorded in clause 8 of this report.
