

7. OURUHIA SCHOOL

Mark Smith, the principal of Ouruhia School, spoke to the Board about the crossing and the need for proper kerbing and a footpath opposite the school.

Mr Smith indicated that this issue was a safety concern. Presently there was no crossing point or widened kerb to help the parents and children to see better when crossing the road.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That the Transport and City Streets Unit investigate the safety concerns and undertake any needed remedial work immediately.
2. That \$22,000 be allocated for this work, from the Shirley/Papanui Discretionary and SCAP funds as follows: \$8,679 to be met from the SCAP budget and the balance funding of \$13,321 to be met from the Board's 2004/05 Discretionary budget.
