1. CORRESPONDENCE

1.1 PROJECT EMPLOYMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME

A letter was received from Guy Adams, Project Employment and Environmental Enhancement Programme, thanking the Board for the contribution of \$10,000 for supervisor wages. The Board **received** the information.

1.2 THOMSON PARK PLANTING PROBLEMS

A letter was received from Dave East, North New Brighton Residents' Association, thanking the Board for the prompt and positive action taken over the planting problems at Thomson Park. The Board **received** the information.

2. RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS/COMMUNITY GROUPS

Time is allocated at Board meetings for Residents' Association/Community Group representatives to address the Board on local matters. Each group is being invited to do this in rotation.

Nigel Dixon from the Ascot/Freeville Residents' Association was in attendance to outline the group's activities.

Concerns raised were:

- Damage to the cycleway planting and grass verge, and rubbish on Frosts Road (between Ascot Avenue and Beach Road).
- Parking problems when events are held at QEII (eg Weetbix triathlon), cars were illegally parking
 on the grass at the Anzac Drive/Travis Road roundabout, even though there were no stopping
 signs in place.

The above concerns were noted for follow-up.

Nigel also reported that the outcomes of the 10-year QEII Concept Plan were positive and stated that residents in the area will be meeting to discuss the outcomes. He also to wished to acknowledge on behalf of the Residents' Association and the local community their appreciation of the excellent work and responses given by Alan Direen and his team.

He also noted that the Council's website 'Request for Service' facility works very well for the community with quick responses to problems raised.

7. QUEENSPARK DRIVE - PARKING RESTRICTION

The Area Engineer (Community) sought the Board's approval for the installation of a 5 minute parking restriction between the hours of 8.00 to 9.00 am and 2.30 to 3.30 pm, Monday to Friday outside the Queenspark School, Parklands.

The Board **resolved** that the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 5 minutes between the hours of 8.00 to 9.00 am and 2.30 to 3.30 pm, Monday to Friday on the eastern side of Queenspark Drive, commencing at a point 308 metres from its intersection with Radiata Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
