ECAN ELECTORAL REVIEW

Councillors were presented with additional information that had been requested at the 7 February seminar.

Councillors generally agreed that the officer's report that would go to the full Council should take into consideration the following:

- 1. The Council wants to send a strong message that it does not support the continued use of the current electoral system and wants to initiate a review to find a better way to ensure fair and equitable representation of area councils, large and small.
- 2. The Council recognises that the legislative change necessary to achieve 1. is a complicated and lengthy process, therefore, until that time, the Council would support option 3 (8 representatives) of the four presented by staff (the "fuzzy edge" proposal being the fourth).
- 3. The Council requests that under the current system, representatives be elected at large.
