

3. DEPUTATION BY APPOINTMENT

Students from South New Brighton School were present to discuss traffic issues outside their school.



Issues identified included traffic speed, the small size of road signage, cycling on footpaths, misuse of the pedestrian crossings, over-parking on the P5 time-restricted areas, the extra heavy vehicles from the Ocean Outfall project, and the undersize of the Bridge Street roundabout.

A special request was also made for Council to install a 40 kph School Speed Zone (it is included in the Draft LTCCP, but a higher priority was sought).

The students also advised the Board of actions they will be taking to raise the awareness of these issues with parents.

In thanking the students, parents and School Principal for attending the meeting, the Chair advised that the Transport and City Streets Unit would be asked to respond to their concerns as soon as possible.
