## 5. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

## 5.1 MRS M RULE

Mrs Rule, of the Sumner Redcliffs Historical Society, addressed the Board regarding the history of the development and naming of Shag Rock Reserve and associated roading. Lady Christina McCombs and Norman Webb also spoke to the historical place names of the area. A request was put forward to change the signage on the portion of Sumner Road under the cliffs to read "Sumner Road" without reference to "Peacock's Gallop". Relevant historical information was tabled at the meeting.

The Board **received** the information and requested that staff prepare a report on the naming issues raised by Mrs Rule, to include consideration of historical or interpreted Maori names as an appropriate choice for the area in question and also to include information as to any costs associated with renaming.

## 5.2 PORT HILLS ROAD SUBDIVISION

Margaret Smith and Marguerite van Eijkman raised issues surrounding the development on Port Hills Road, to include resulting problems with flooding, drainage, property level changes and safety concerns. They raised questions as to whether the development was in compliance with notification requirements and with the terms of issued resource consents.

The Board **received** the information and requested information from staff as to the terms of any resource consents and variances and information concerning Council's Resource Consent Communications Plan.
