



4. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

4.1 DR JOHN COOK, NEW BRIGHTON HEALTHCARE, UNION STREET

Dr Cook addressed the Board about his concerns relating to the 10-metre road width and the higher speeds that could result from this, the need for better visibility caused by berm tree placement, off street parking for the medical centre, and the turning manoeuvres of vehicles exiting driveways.

The Board, in receiving the deputation, addressed these issues under clause 9 of this report.

Ross Paterson, Christchurch Community Gardens Association, and Sue Cobb, New Brighton Community Garden, were in attendance to discuss community gardens in Christchurch.
