## 3. COMMUNITY BOARD PRINCIPAL ADVISER'S UPDATE

The Board received the information and decided:

1. To make an addition to the Board's submission on the Aquatics Facilities Plan as follows:

"The Board would like to recommend a particular focus on currently available land bounding Bromley East and Oxidation Ponds. This land is of limited commercial use and as a result, Bromley East faces an isolated future with no local focus. The Board would like to suggest that comprehensive analysis be conducted to not only the recreational impact of a facility in the area, but also the long-term social gains for an immensely under-resourced and under-serviced area with a significantly high level of deprivation."

- 2. To hold a seminar meeting at 2.00 pm prior to the Board's meeting on 8 March 2006 to discuss the Board's submission on the heritage provisions in the City Plan.
- 3. That Board members would convey any comments regarding the Earthquake-Prone, Dangerous and Insanitary Buildings Policy to the Community Board Principal Adviser, with a draft Board submission to be prepared, if required, for the 22 February 2006 meeting.
