PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To seek Council's approval of the proposed wording of a plaque to be installed adjacent to a commemorative tree planted in 2003.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2. On 11 November 2003 Chev Gorg Spiteri planted an almond tree in the Cambridge Terrace riverbank area downstream of the Bridge of Remembrance, now known as the Park of Remembrance. It was planted at a ceremony attended by the Mayor, in tribute to the servicemen and women who defended Malta in the second world war.
- 3. The plaque was not installed at the time, and Mr Spiteri now wishes to install it at the base of the tree. He proposes to use the words that were entered in the Commemorative Tree Plantings book at the time:

Malta GC

THIS MEMORIAL IS TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THE SERVICEMEN AND WOMEN WHO DEFENDED THE ISLAND OF MALTA AGAINST SUSTAINED ATTACK DURING THE SECOND WORLD WAR.

SUCH WAS THE VALOUR SHOWN BY THE DEFENDERS OF THE "ISLAND FORTRESS" THAT KING GEORGE VI AWARDED THE ISLAND THE GEORGE CROSS FOR BRAVERY AND COURAGE 15 APRIL 1942.
