1. RICCARTON/WIGRAM COMMUNITY BOARD FUNDING ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT FOR 2005/06

The Board considered an accountability matrix, detailing the allocations made from its 2004/05 Project and Discretionary Funds.

The Board had funding of \$390,000 available for the 2005/06 year, comprising \$60,000 Discretionary funding, \$40,000 SCAP and \$390,000 Project funding. At its allocation meeting of 22 March 2005 and 14 June 2005 the Board allocated this funding as follows:
