3. CORRESPONDENCE

3.1 HERITAGE WEEK

The Board considered correspondence from Amanda Ohs, Heritage Planner, concerning the timing of Heritage Week in 2007. It is proposed to alter the timing of this event from October 2007 to June/July 2007 to coincide with the UNESCO World Heritage Convention to be held in Christchurch from 23 June to 1 July 2007.

The Board **decided** to confirm that it would support the moving of Heritage Week forward to June/July for 2007.

3.2 GLOUCESTER STREET

The Board considered correspondence from Mr Colin Sweetman, Bursar, Christ's College Canterbury regarding the proposal for a drop off area located in Gloucester Street.

The Board decided to **receive** the correspondence and to advise the school that this will be forwarded to Transport and Greenspace Unit staff for consideration in association with the report being prepared for the Board on this topic.

A letter from the Inner City East Neighbourhood Group Inc. (ICENG) requesting that a decision on the declaration of the stopped portion of Worcester Street in Latimer Square for recreation reserve be deferred was tabled and discussed by the Board.
