

11. AYLESFORD STREET

The Board's approval was sought to a request from the Christchurch Football Club for a change to the approved neighbourhood improvement works along Aylesford Street.

The Shirley/Papanui Community Board **resolved** to:

- (a) Revoke the concept design approved at its meeting of 21 June 2006, including the following "no stopping" restrictions:
 - (i) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Aylesford Street, commencing at a point 202 metres south of its intersection with Westminster Street and extending 24 metres in a southerly direction.
 - (ii) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Aylesford Street, commencing at a point 183 metres south of its intersection with Westminster Street and extending 35 metres in a southerly direction.
- (b) Approve the alternative concept design for Aylesford Street, together with the following traffic restrictions:

New "No Stopping" restrictions

- (i) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Aylesford Street, commencing at a point 195 metres south of its intersection with Westminster Street and extending 24 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Aylesford Street, commencing at a point 182 metres south of its intersection with Westminster Street and extending 23 metres in a southerly direction.
