HAGLEY/FERRYMEAD COMMUNITY BOARD  
11 JULY 2007

**A meeting of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board  
was held on Wednesday 11 July 2007 at 3.00pm**

**PRESENT:** Bob Todd (Chairperson), David Cox, Anna Crighton (from 3.14pm), John Freeman, Brenda Lowe-Johnson, Brendan Smith and Yani Johanson.

**APOLOGIES:** An apology for lateness was received from Anna Crighton who arrived at 3.14pm and was absent for clause 8 and part of clause 2.1.

The Board reports that:

**1. 1091 FERRY ROAD - BODY CORPORATE 74246**

**2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT**

**2.1 REDCLIFFS RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION**

Alison Powell (President) and Topsy Rule requested that urgent attention be given to the preparation of an acceptable traffic plan for traffic control, including management of the pedestrian crossing at Main Road, Redcliffs, to allow maximum safety for residents. A copy of the written submission from the Association is on file. Submissions from the deputation were considered in association with clause 3.

**3. NOTICE OF MOTION**

The Board considered the following motion, notice of which had been given by Yani Johanson pursuant to Standing Order 2.16.1:

*"That noting the ongoing and long-standing concerns of local people in the Redcliffs area in regards to traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist safety (especially on the Main Road pedestrian crossing), that the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board resolves to get a LATMS (Local Area Traffic Management Scheme) done by Council staff as a priority so that solutions can be sought and improvements made."*

The motion when put to the meeting was declared **lost** on division no. 1 by five votes to two, the voting being as follows:

**Against (5):** David Cox, Anna Crighton, Brenda Lowe-Johnson, Brendan Smith and Bob Todd.  
**For (2):** John Freeman and Yani Johanson.

The Board then **resolved:**

1. To seek information on when the results of the current trial of pedestrian safety warning lights on crossings in Tuam and Hereford Streets will be available to the pedestrian crossing on Main Road, Redcliffs.
2. To seek a report on options for addressing any safety issues with traffic turning into Augusta Street and Beachville Road and the Main Road, Redcliffs.

(The foregoing resolution was declared **carried** on division no. 2 by 7 votes to 0 (unanimous).

- (c) "Puriwhero Lane" for the formed right-of-way off Main Road, Sumner.
