33. URBAN DESIGN PANEL

BACKGROUND

- 1. At last week's Council meeting the Council had before it a report recommending the establishment of an urban design panel. The Council agreed to the establishment of the panel and to a 3 year trial.
- 2. The Council did not agree to the staff recommendation regarding the budget and resolved:

To seek a further report from the Chief Executive on the budget for this project and the panel composition.

3. Regarding panel composition the report stated:

The proposed panel would be composed of four established professionals and would include expertise in urban design, architecture, property and development. The members would be selected from a pool of panellists nominated by professional institutes and the Property Council and approved by the Council.

- 4. The Council did resolve that the Council itself appoint the members of the Panel on the recommendation of the Mayor and the Chief Executive.
- 5. Regarding the issue of budget the report recommended:

Approves additional funding of \$218,000 (\$65,000 in 2007/08 and \$153,000 in 2008/09) as a fixed term project to cover the costs of an 18 month trial period for an Urban Design Panel.

6. With the move from an 18 month trial to a three year trial that recommendation should now read:

Approves additional funding of \$422,500 (\$65,000 in 2007/08, and \$153,000 in each of 2008/09 and 2009/10, and \$51,500 in 2010/11) as a fixed term project to cover the costs of a three year trial period for an Urban Design Panel.

- 7. The staff have held a discussion with the Mayor regarding both the Panel composition and the budget.
- 8. I believe it is now appropriate for the Council to approve the revised recommendation regarding the funding of the three year trial.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Council approve additional funding of \$422,500 (\$65,000 in 2007/08, and \$153,000 in each of 2008/09 and 2009/10, and \$51,500 in 2010/11) as a fixed term project to cover the costs of a three year trial period for an Urban Design Panel.
