The streetlight art cost was approximately \$18,257 at the time of construction, plus erection costs. Please note that these costs were as of approximately 1999/2000. The bridge was initially funded by the CCC, and later became a State Highway under Transit NZ. The final design of the bridge was part of the resource consent process, and meeting the conditions of that consent, the aim being to reflect the surrounding environment and provide a gateway to Travis Swamp. |
