Need for eradication of noxious plants  
 - Boneseed / salt bush.  
Residents have pulled thousands of these with some success in the Park but vigilance is ongoing necessity  
 - Cotoneaster (glanophyllus)  
This plant threatens to take over the hillside  
Public awareness and ACTION is needed. The Council could surely instruct staff and probably marshal local help.

STREETS Whitewash Head Rd. (not listed)
