To all councillors. Refers my Submission re City plan. I have perused the city plan and comment as follows.

I object to more Libraries as I feel the city has it's libraries distributed and available to visit fairy well.

I would however recommend New Brighton Library be expanded to accommodate it's ever growing work load.

I feel that when considering road planning, the joining of Pegasus to Ferry mead wards, by means of a Bridge across the Estuary from south shore would make good sense, the Small area of large yachts still being possible if this were positioned correctly. To Join South Shore and Sumner would enhance our seaside suburbs.

The outfall should be scrapped and instead UV disinfection used solely for treatment from the ponds to clean the water to bathing standard, saving rate payers fifty plus million and an Ecological disaster then discharged at a mid channel discharge point, near the summer bar. This pipe from Bromley to be part of the road construction, in other words a pipe within the new road across from the end of the spit. The pipe could then be continued out to the sand bar and be discharged, out of the Estuary and as safe bathing water Quality standard waste water. In future years if this water is required for use on the land it would not be to late to do this.

The recycling of kitchen scraps to be rethought, with a choice of individuals to drop off their waste at specified recycling points i.e. the dump

Christchurch residents would abuse the waste option and put anything in the scraps bag therefore jeopardising the reason for doing it in the first place.

For future years I request a one or two page summary sheet for ratepayers to view the plan as none of us has time to read through the enormous document.

I would also take this opportunity to oppose the LGC representation arrangements for the CCC 2004 Elections i.e. 12 Councillors.

I also oppose the Amalgamation of Banks Peninsula with CCC as a costly and unfair decision to CCC ratepayers.

I also oppose the building of a new Council Building.

Offices will always be "a rabbit warren" be it a new Building or an older one, it is simply the nature of working in a large building. Leaky windows can be fixed they should be. Pleas confirm receipt ,written only.
