I wish to speak about the main points in my submission at the hearings from 1-11 June.

I wish to make a submission re lack of pedestrian crossings on Springfield Rd especially as it is now used as an alternative to Papanui Rd, with the resultant increase & speed of traffic. It is very difficult for elderly people with failing eyesight or other disabilities to get across. I would suggest either Islands, pedestrian crossings, lights, or perhaps speed bumps might be considered.

Also the Edgware stopping area is another difficult place for elderly to cross, with only one official pedestrian crossing & several roads converging: - i.e. Trafalgar St., Edgware Rd, & Kolombo St.

I hope you will please examine these situations with a view to improvements being made.
