	<p>There is NO PROVISION for a flat water facility in the draft LTCCP.</p> <p>A flat water facility is rated #1 priority by the sporting community.</p> <p>CCC previously allocated \$11 million for a flat water facility, but has not delivered.</p> <p>CCC has not investigated the new site for Lake Isaac, located over 4km from the airport.</p> <p>The Airport's concern over birdstrike is the only obstacle for CCC.</p> <p>Numerous examples exist of successful bird management near airports.</p> <p>The facility must be accessible on a daily basis. There are no viable alternative sites to Lake Isaac.</p> <p>Kerr's Reach is substandard - overcrowded, weed infested &amp; unsafe.</p> <p>The water quality of the Avon River does not meet Ministry for the Environment Contact Recreation standard.</p>
