To the Christchurch City Council

I wish to make the following submission in regard to the Wastewater Collection and Treatment.

In the present climate with water shortages for irrigation and the ever climbing estimates of the Ocean Outfall project, I would very strongly suggest that you do further costings on pumping the waste water inland to a lake for irrigation.

The Ocean outfall disposal may be the cheaper option at this stage but looking to the future it may be the most costly of all. One only has to look at the spiralling costs of the Waimakariri District Outfall project and the problems and costs will be ongoing because of the type of sand beaches along our coastline.

Expenditure to pipe the waste water inland would benefit land use on the dry Canterbury Plains, produce an income from Users with minimal maintenance costs.

The sea does not need anymore water, but as the rivers have not nearly the same volume of water in them due to irrigation, please do not waste this opportunity to utilise this most needed commodity.
