I would like the funding allocation of \$11 million for a flat water facility (Lake Isaac Water Sports Park) be REINSTATED in the LTCCP.

. There is NO PROVISION for a flat water facility in the draft LTCCP.

. A flat water facility is rated #1 priority by the sporting community.

. CCC previously allocated \$11 million for a flat water facility, but has not delivered.

. CCC has not investigated the new site for Lake Isaac, located over 4km from the airport.

. The Airport's concern over birdstrike is the only obstacle for CCC.
