1. Belfast Pool was built by the community in 1978 and has operated solely by community support up to the last five or so seasons.

The Council has operated the pool for the last 3 seasons.

Belfast Community pool still claims ownership of this pool. Its operation ^{only} was handed over to the Council in.

3 Since then Committee involvement has been blocked at every quarter, access is denied, advice & offers of financial assistance for maintenance or enhancement has been ignored.

4 Usage figures have long been corrupted by the omission of school usage by mainly Belfast School and any other school that has hired its usage - Seventh Day adventist school

5 Usage figures have been skewed this season by free admissions. Proper headcounts have not been made.

6 Even if a new facility is built in Papanui, the area serviced by Belfast pool is still sufficiently far away to still be a desirable recreational facility for the community, from Redwood, Casbrooke Northcote to Belfast Kaianga Brooklands & Spencerville and Marshlands.
