sub 1

Issue: proposed \$2.6m on No 2 Drain through golf course.

action requested: Undertake repairs ony until all options examined and reported. Give special attention to the option of a shallower waterway with a freshwater basin and wetland within an existing low area north of the golf course.

reason: The \$2.6m proposed by the Council is far too high.

sub 2:

issue: Christchurch Perimeter Walkway.

action requested: The Council to require and consider a report on the development and promotion of such a walkway.

reason: The walkway route has already been identified by a sizable group very keen to have the many benefits of the walk recognised. There is a high benefit to cost ratio.

sub 3:

issue: Central City Street Tree Planting Scheme.

action requested: The Council to require and consider a scheme for the next budget round.

reasons: There is a loss of private trees when redevelopment to higher densities takes place in the residential areas of the central city. Recent new tree planting has been poorly done. The trees need to be closer than the 30 to 40 metres currently used, be small with an open canopy and be protected from vandalism.
