Elaboration is needed to identify which Community Halls &amp; Centres are being considered for closure. A detailed explanation is needed to show how the estimated savings of \$397,000 has been arrived at.</p> <p>2. There is need for a clear policy statement on the delegation of powers and authorities to bodies administering such premises on behalf of the Council. This will not necessarily mean that all authorisations will be identical for every building. There needs to be a much clearer and direct line of communication available for administering bodies to a Council officer with authority to make prompt decisions to resolve operational conflicts.</p> <p>Rich3. Where reports are obtained by Council on the state, operation or usage of any Community Hall or Centre, such reports should be made available to the administering body for comment. Where, as a result of such a report, some action by the Council is likely, the administering body should be afforded an opportunity to make representations before any final Council decision on such action is made.</p>
