	<p>I oppose strongly the closure of the 3 suburban libraries. They are the sources of education for all, and also a recreation facility for disabled, elderly and the young as well. It has been proposed to leave only the Papanui library existing the northern part of Christchurch - this is located in an area surrounded by very busy traffic, little parking and it would be extremely unadvisable to let children up to intermediate age go there alone. I personally have stopped going to the Northlands mall for this very reason of traffic safety.</p> <p>A new physical recreation centre is being built at the Bishopdale Mall and it seems ironic that those who wish for the less physical recreation activity of learning, reading and research will be the worse off. This is unbalanced thinking.
