Your Submission:	Do you have any comments on the major projects in our Draft Community Plan?
	I think cutting library services is wrong (page 8) and there is no appreciation of their educational value in the plan. Christchurch already has quite minimal public library services compared to Auckland and Wellington. The amount to be spent on new roads is excessive, and the money would be better spent on public transport. Additional parking revenue could be earned by charging people for parking on the street in the suburbs, e.g. around Canterbury University. Increasing cemetery charges, beyond recovering costs, is a very unfair way of raising money because you can't avoid dying. The satisfaction aim for cycleways is too low (page 18).
