	I strongly oppose the Council proposal to rationalise community libraries by closing Redwood, Bishopdale and Spreydon. I have lived in the Redwood area for over 14 years and use the local library often. I have a 5 year old son who loves going to the library - we often walk there, getting our exercise at the same time as choosing books, tapes, CD's and CD Roms. He would be devastated if it shut - its too far for him to walk to Papanui - and too dangerous for him to bike. As he gets older we would like to use the local library to resource projects for school. The wider community would be affected if the library shut - the Redwood Shopping Centre which includes the library - is always busy - people walking, biking and driving to avail themselves of the shops and the local amenities - library, park, kindergarten, childcare centre.
