Your Submission:	Do you have any comments on the major projects in our Draft Community Plan?
	The plan refers to a sum of \$132M over 10 years for projects in Banks Peninsula but does not go into detail on these projects. As the major tourism operator on the Peninsula we have raised the issue of sub standard boarding facilities in both Lyttelton and Akaroa. Lyttelton needs a new ferry terminal at the west end of the port. Akaroa needs an additional set of steps and a boarding ramp on the Main Wharf.
	Do you have any comments on groups of activities (The activities and services the Council provides?)
	Page 116 refers to attracting visitors to Christchurch. This should also include attacting visitors to Banks Peninsula.
	Page 119 refers to an additional \$36,000 to undertake visitor promotions for Banks Peninsula. This is not enough and creates a lose-lose situation for both Christchurch and Canterbury Marketing and tourism on Banks Peninsula. The previous BP tourism and economic development officer had a budget of \$150,000 which included a salary. An additional \$100,000 is required to adequately represent Banks Peninsula in future.

	I seek a change to the Vision which refers only to Christchurch but now also should include Banks Peninsula.
