2 Do you have any comments on groups of activities (the activities and services that Council provides)? page number

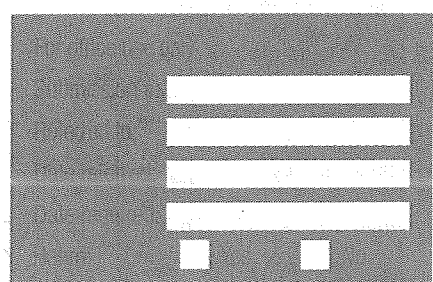
Good, to have a say. Hope you ALL agree.
