The kindness and generosity of Pub Charities has enabled people with disabilities to enjoy the interactive sound floor and to feel empowered by the control gained when moving across it.

People with visual impairment can now reliably hear the sound as they touch or step on each panel. People with partial vision can enjoy watching the panels light up as they are touched. The increased sensitivity of the panels enables people to activate sound and light the way they choose to, increasing independence, confidence and control.

"It's fantastic to see my daughter enjoy herself so much. She is usually pushed around in her wheelchair but on the sound floor she is so motivated by the sound and light effects that she can't wait to move onto the next panel. She tries really hard and manages to move herself along with the joystick on her electric wheelchair – stopping to giggle each time the sound and light is activated" Parent.
