Your Submission:	<p>Do you have any comments on the major projects in our Draft Community Plan?</p> <p>1) Page 79 of full version</p> <p>Seek retention of: Total of-street cycle network project - to redirect cycling from main roads to off-road corridors, priority 1.</p> <p>Reason: Cycles and cycle lanes on arterial roads are not a good fit as the primary function of arterial roads is for the movement of cars, vans etc and heavy commercial vehicles; I made a submission (and spoke at a hearing) some 10 years ago to the Proposed City Plan about this and the submission was accepted by the hearing committee.</p> <p>Mixing with heavy traffic is a barrier to cycling for many people - and deters me to a degree. Cycling away from heavy traffic is much more pleasant and safer.</p> <p>I have cycled in Europe on a number of excellent cycle routes; an off-street cycle network is a great vision for the city to work towards.</p> <p>2) Page 155 full version</p> <p>I seek retention of the proposed funding for cycle and pedestrian linkages off-street. If practicable there would seem to be benefits in bringing forward projects that have been identified for improving cycling and walking.</p> <p>Reason - many obvious benefits to alternative of car transport. The budgeting for these is about 1% of the budget for streets and transport; this amount seems to be modest within the overall picture.</p>
