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In your new acquired lands on BR, no toilets exist in Hickory or Magnet Camp, both popular (100+ visitors per day) (lower summer) destinations for local folk. I strongly suggest this is unacceptable but supplying a norwaki style facility as the Dal does in the backcountry areas would help alleviate the mess & issues created in these areas of high conservation values by city residents. If such funding for such projects is unavailable perhaps bringing in a poopot scheme as used by alpinists in AMC National Park could help mitigate the issue short term until full responsibility is taken."
